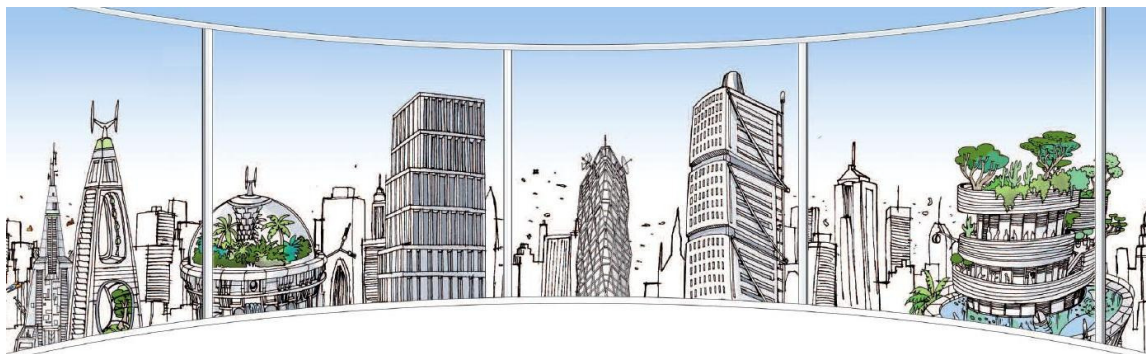


CAPSULES

Requirements

This course is for advanced users who intend to design analytical applications in Board version 7. The toolkit approach is introduced, which allows the user to create their own application via dragging and dropping objects and defining parameters. During the 3 days, all of the Board objects will be introduced and described in detail. The course will also review the concept of linking objects, using procedures to run calculations within board, and how to setup jobs to automate print jobs and data loading routines. Advanced topics

include how to create data entry environments to do budgeting, planning, and simulation, as well as reviewing the use of Board as a Corporate Performance Management solution. We will also provide tips and tricks for the best approach for developing capsules.
